

RYA Courses for Adults

These courses are for complete beginners - RYA Level 1 - Start Sailing—through to those who have already sailed a little perhaps on holiday or on a course some years ago and need a 'refresher' - RYA Level 2 - Basic Skills. Depending on your experience and aptitude this three and a half day course will either have you complete the L1 course and well on your way to L2, or get you to L2 itself which will give you the capability and confidence to take a boat out without an instructor in light winds.

Cost: £195.00 (£165.00 for 14-17 year olds.) Non club members £195.00 plus an introductory membership fee of £60.00 which includes 1 months membership following the course. These courses include use of club boats, buoyancy aids and RYA Logbook. RYA Start Racing and Seamanship Skills courses arranged subject to demand.
