General Notes and Instructions

Arrival

The clubhouse and changing facilities will be open from 9.15 am each day.

The briefing will be at 10.00 am on Monday 29th July. Please make sure the children are registered, changed and ready in good time for the briefing.

We hope to be off the water at 4.00 pm and packed away by 5.00 pm.

Personal Equipment

- Wet weather sailing gear (including a wetsuit if possible, and windproof top)
- Sailing clothes <u>plus</u> at least one complete change of clothes
- Trainers/sailing shoes (extra to their normal shoes)
- A towel
- Sun hat/cap and sun cream
- A buoyancy aid (supplied with the hire boat if you are hiring one)

Please ensure you bring everything on the personal equipment list, and mark all personal items with name or initials so they may be returned to you. The club cannot accept any liability for lost items.

Adult helpers

Please come prepared for all kinds of weather, as there will be little protection from the elements!

Privately owned Boat Equipment

Dinghy in proper sailing condition including:

- Secure and effective buoyancy
- Bailer attached by a lanyard
- Painter at least 4 metres long attached to the bow

Particularly ensure that your dinghy is properly equipped and <u>all</u> items marked with the boat number, and that the <u>personal</u> and dinghy buoyancy is in top condition. These items will be checked on arrival and you will not be allowed on the water unless the Senior Instructor is satisfied.

Food and Drink

Drinks are provided mid morning and afternoon, and at lunchtime for each child and designated helpers. Lunch tickets will be issued to each child and to key helpers daily.

If it is hot, you are advised to provide your children with a (disposable) bottle of water.

We plan to offer an opportunity for parents not helping the opportunity to buy a meal. Expect further information at a later date.

Tuesday BBQ

There will be a BBQ on Tuesday about 4.30-5.00 pm, for the children and their families.

Meat will be provided for sailors, but we ask that parents, and other family members attending, provide their own meat for cooking on the BBQ.

A volunteer will be sought from the parents to co-ordinate the contributions of salads, puddings etc.

Wednesday Prize Giving.

This will take place as soon as everything is packed away. Many hands make light work!

General Conditions

To ensure the smooth running of Chipmates and to provide a safe environment for young people to learn how to sail, we have to have a certain number of conditions.

- 1. Please note that children under 7 cannot be included in the event. The child must have had his/her 7th birthday and be 15 or under at the start of the event.
- 2. A Parent/Guardian must be present at the club at all times during the event. You will be asked when registering your child/children, who will be in attendance as the responsible parent/guardian for each day. It is essential that, in the case of any mishaps, a parent or trusted guardian is available for a child to turn to for comfort and support. If you need to leave the club for a short period during the event, you must arrange for another person to take responsibility for your child when they come off the water and please ensure that you leave a contact number whilst you are absent.
- 3. Chipmates is an event run entirely by volunteers and we require significant assistance from parents or guardians. A help form is attached for you to indicate the type of help that you can offer, and you will be advised which duties you are assigned to before the event.
- 4. If you are using your own boat, it must be in full working order and have adequate secure buoyancy. The boat must have valid insurance, and you will be asked to attest to this at the start of the 3 days.
 - For non-owners, limited numbers of dinghies with buoyancy aids are available to hire. Buoyancy aids and marine insurance are provided with the hire boats.
- We reserve the right to interchange helms, crews and boats where we consider it to be necessary. In the case of boat owners we reserve the right to levy a charge if it becomes necessary to employ a hire boat.
- 6. Please return your application form, accompanied by the Health form, Help form, and your cheque as soon as possible. Whilst we cannot guarantee a place for the event, a prompt response helps your chance of being accepted.
