NOTICE OF SERIES

1 RULES

- 1.1 The Series will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS),
- 1.2 Under RRS 87, the International Laser Class Association ILCA Class Rules will apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 There will be no Series sailing instructions.

3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 Any Series communications will be through the ILCA UK South Coast Region web page, https://ilca.uk/grandprix-southcoast, and the associated South Coast Grand Prix ILCA Sailing (facebook.com).

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Series is open to sailors who are members of the International Laser Class Association sailing Standard/ILCA 7, Radial/ILCA 6 or 4.7/ILCA 4 that comply with the Class rules.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering online at <u>UKLA : Events (ilca.uk)</u> together with the required fee.
- 4.3 A sailor will only receive a score for an event if they have entered the Series before midnight on the final day of that event.
- 4.4 Competitors will receive Series scores for the ILCA rig in which they sail an event. The ILCA rigs will be scored separately.
- 4.5 Sailors who travel to Series events are strongly encouraged to enter the Grand Prix Series.

5 FEES

5.1 The entry fee for the Series will be £5.00.

6 SCHEDULE

6.1 The events below will qualify for the Series. Within the Series, there will be three regional mini-series and inland‡, harbour & estuary♥ and sea♠ mini series.

6.2 Dates of racing: as identified on the ILCA UK website events page.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 Each event will have separate results for each rig.
- 7.2 Where a Cub produces results for combined rigs, the Series results will be separated in to the individual rigs.
- 7.3 A sailor will score her overall placing for the specific rig in the event.
- 7.4 A helm that does not compete in an event shall score one more than the number of entries in the series as at midnight on the first day of the final event.
- 7.5 Events hosted by at least two different Clubs are required to be completed to constitute a series (and mini series).
- 7.6 The number of events to count towards a sailor's score will be the lower of half the number of events completed rounded down or six.
- 7.7 Note: an event may qualify for a score in more Grand Prix series than the South.

8 DATA PROTECTION

8.1 The organizing authority will use the information provided on the registration for the purposes of administering the Series in accordance with the RRS, to which the persons completing the registration will agree to be bound. The legal basis for processing information is contract. In accordance with the RRS, personal information contained on registration may be shared with the RYA and may publish, the name under which you register, boat details and Series/event/race results; it will share these with the RYA. By electing to pay by GoCardless, you will agree to its terms and conditions. UKLA may take photographs and video footage of the individual events for use by us in connection with publication in the sailing Press, the website and by Series sponsors.

9 PRIZES

- 9.1 Prizes will be awarded to the ILCA Grand Prix Series South champion, the top placed Youth, Masters and Lady and the winners of each regional mini-series, the winner of the inland, harbour & estuary and sea mini-series. Additional prizes may be awaa.uk/events?tags%5B%rded at the discretion of ILCA UK.
- 9.2 Prize givings for each regional mini-series shall take place with the club prize giving at the final scheduled event of the mini-series, and at Chichester Yacht Club for the overall Series.
